

How to apply for TCS Campus Commune Competitions_2016:

Students need to follow the below mentioned steps to register in the contest.

- a) Log on to the NextStep portal using the following link: <https://nextstep.tcs.com>.
- b) Choose IT and then Click on the tab 'register here'.
- c) Click 'Off Campus Applicant' to fill and submit the registration form.
- d) Students can choose "Others" in institute name, in case their institute name is not appearing in the drop down and then manually feed institute name.
- e) Students can feed the password in form of "Tcs@1234"
- f) DT Ref ID will be displayed on the screen immediately on submission of the form. The candidate will also receive his/her CT Ref ID and password on his registered email Id after the form has been submitted. Candidates are required to note the DT id with them.
- g) The students now need to login with the DT number and set password to be able to land into the home page of nextstep portal.
- h) Students then click on "Campus Commune Tab".




